



## ASI Summer Program Update

Successful applicants for the 2009 Summer Program will be notified within the first two weeks of May. The program will run at the same two locations as last year: Notre Dame Catholic Elementary School at 2751 Partington Avenue in Windsor and Holy Name Catholic Elementary School at 200 Fairview Avenue West in Essex. The program will begin Monday, July 6 and run until Friday, August 21.

In 2008, ASI expanded its program by adding an additional classroom and conducting a pilot project. Two classrooms at the Windsor location worked with a 2:1 ratio rather than the normal 1:1 ratio. This allowed us to serve more families. We're happy to say that we will be implementing this again this year. Two classes will be set up at the Windsor location with a 2:1 ratio with a maximum of eight children in each classroom.

## Fundraising Initiative for all ASI Summer Program Families

In response to the ever-increasing waiting list and some major financial challenges faced by ASI regarding its Summer Programs a meeting was held in February with ASI families to discuss options to address these issues. It was concluded that the preferred direction was to raise revenues through increased fundraising and to accomplish this a formal parent's fundraising association would be established.

Families wanting to see the current level of service continue as well as reducing, or preferably eliminating, the waiting list are encouraged to get involved in fundraising. A meeting date to discuss innovative fundraising ideas and ways families can be involved will be announced soon. Please watch for this important announcement.

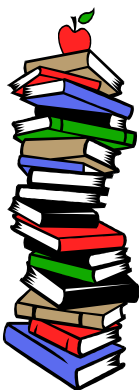
